Information for Dancers

The Information Desk is located in the Foyer of the venue.

Venue Opening Times – The venue will be opened approximately 30 minutes prior to the start of each session.

Registered Dancers – Your Convention Ribbon is both your identification and ticket. Please wear it at all times, including at the Dancer Interest Meeting on Sunday morning. Ribbons are Non-transferable and the "No Ribbon, No Dancing" rule applies.

Dress Code – Square dance attire is required at all evening dance sessions except for our **50's Rock 'n' Roll** theme night on Monday. Afternoon sessions can be square dance attire or smart casual; no beachwear, sportswear or workwear.

Banners – Please leave your banner at the Information Desk on arrival. If you require your banner to be returned on Sunday, please advise us. Otherwise, your banner may be collected from the Information Desk on Monday afternoon.

Light Refreshments will be available from the foyer café at all sessions. Please ensure that no food or drink is carried or consumed on the dance floor (own water bottles allowed).

Booths - Enjoy the range of products available for sale, all located in Hall 3 accessed from the foyer.

Lost Property – Please report, deliver, or collect all lost property to or from the Information Desk.

Registered Non-Dancers & Stall Holders – Please wear your identification ticket at all times.

Visitors & Spectators – Please ensure you register on arrival, and wear your identification ticket at all times.

Parents/Guardians are responsible for their children at all times except when their children are in our organised child minding facility.

Information for Dancers

First Aid – St John Ambulance Volunteers are in attendance at all sessions during the Convention. The First Aid area is located in the foyer. Please familiarise yourself with the ECMA procedure on page 8 of this booklet.

COVID & Hand Hygiene – We encourage hand hygiene and you are welcome to wear a mask. There are sanitisers throughout the venue. Please sanitise after each bracket. If you are feeling unwell or suspect you may have COVID please: STAY AWAY FROM THE VENUE, get tested for COVID and if positive tell the committee. If the COVID test is negative, but you are feeling unwell, please stay away from the venue.

The Child Minding Area is located in Hall 2 each evening. Access is available to registered children and their parents or quardians, care givers, staff and committee only.

Shoes – Shoes with heels less than 25 mm square (one inch) will not be permitted on any dance floor for dancer safety and to avoid marking the floors. Dancers must not use any substance on their shoes or place any substance on the floor. Metal shoe taps on clogging shoes must be covered with tape at all times.

Dancer Safety – In consideration for fellow dancers and in the interest of safety, please avoid attaching items such as keys and badges etc, to your waist whilst dancing.

Recording - Please be aware that music is usually subject to copyright and recording may contravene this.

Stage - The presence on stage of people other than performers, invited guests and stage management staff is not permitted.

Photograph area – A backdrop for photographs is located in the foyer.

- When a dancer goes down, a second dancer attends him/her
- Remaining couples join hands and take a step backward. This will allow the injured person and attendant air and room
- Raise joined hands as high as possible in the form of an arched circle
- On seeing this signal, the caller or hall monitor will immediately place an Emergency Call For Medical Aid


